2016 Clean Water Indiana Grid Sampling Application

- 1. Interested parties need to complete an application for cost-share assistance for each Individual program.
2. Property must be located in Lawrence County.
3. Receipts must be completed and turned in after completion
4. Applications must be approved by the board of supervisors before cost-share will be paid.

Grid Sampling (approved applications)

- 1. Cost share for Grid Sampling will be \$10 per acre up to 100 acres.(maximum of \$1,000)
2. Project must follow NRCS standards.

- 2) Complete application package at Lawrence County SWCD office for review and schedule an office appointment with District Technician.
- 3) Items you will receive at the SWCD Technician appointment:
  - Conservation Plan
  - Plan Map
- 4) Complete according to NRCS documents.
- 5) Bring all receipts to Lawrence County.
- 6) Payment will be approved at a Lawrence County SWCD board meeting after receipts have been verified to meet NRCS standards.
